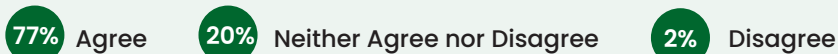


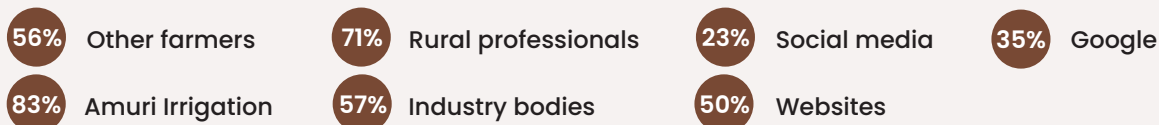
Survey Results

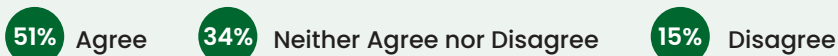
Question 1: I know what environmental regulations relate to my farming business.



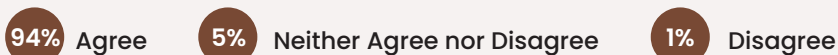
Question 2: I know where to find the information I need on environmental regulation.



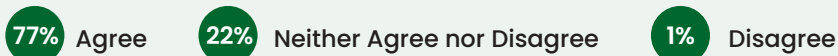
Question 3: I know how current regulations will affect my business.



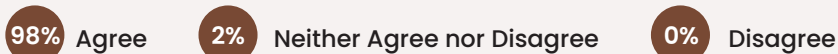
Question 4: I understand how my on-farm actions impact my catchment.



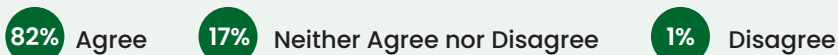
Question 5: I am willing to change.



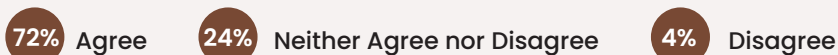
Question 6: Improving farm practices is important.
